Deposit

- A \$500 deposit is required to guarantee your reservation.
- A minimum of 12 guests required for catering. Additional catering charges apply for groups under 12.

Cancellation Policy

- Deposit is non-refundable.
- If function is cancelled 30 days prior to arrival, 100% of total fee is due.
- If function is cancelled 31-90 days prior to arrival, 75% of total fee is due.
- If function is cancelled 91 or more days prior to your arrival, 50% of total fee is due.
- You will be billed for the number of persons you guarantee 7 days prior to your arrival.
